Parent Agreement:

- Tuition is due on the 1st of the month.
- Tuition payment must be received in the school office by the 15th day of the month or a \$25 late fee will be added per month. Failure to meet tuition obligations may result in collection proceedings including, but not limited to, tuition and fees, collection costs, attorneys' fees and any other reasonable litigation expenses.
- The non-member of St. Peter Parish tuition amount will be charged unless this form is signed by Father indicating that you are: **formally registered at the parish, attend Mass regularly, and use your weekly envelopes.**
- A \$25 NSF (non-sufficient funds) fee will be charged for any checks returned marked NSF.
- All tuition for the current school year must be paid in full by **May 15** of that year or student(s) will not receive diplomas, transcripts or participate in graduation ceremonies, or be eligible for enrollment the following year.
- ***I understand that if at any time these commitments cannot be fulfilled, I must contact the school principal to discuss my situation and to make payment arrangements. (If you are two months behind we may ask that your child(ren) remain home until payment is received.)***
